Is *World Campus – Japan* for me?

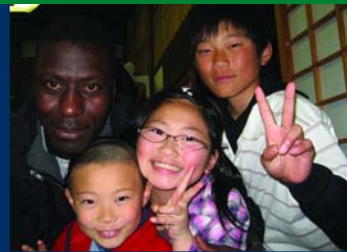
